Please see processes in place for deliveries to towers when AP Delivery staff arrive. We spoke with the State Control Centre (SCC) to provide us the processes they set in place with VICPOL and DHHS to deliver mail. Our Delivery Team has been advised and provided a letter of exemption (from the SCC) to enter the area to deliver mail.

RE: Deliveries to North Melbourne lockdown towers

9:00am – s 47 and I arrived at the Command Post on Bunclie St. We tried to speak with Tom Robertson your original contact from this morning, but he was in a morning briefing.

Simon Were, a direct report to Tom liaised with s 47 and I. We outlined the importance of accepting responsibility of all items and the possible sensitivity of some items.

Simon acknowledged taking responsibility of all mail and parcels items.

Upon arrival our temperatures were checked and we had to sign in, we were offered gloves and masks but we had them already on.

We scanned all 220 articles and placed them in numerical order from highest to lowest per tower.

Simon advised us to store the articles and mail behind the entry checkpoint as it would be manned at all times and secure in this location.

We walked Simon through the order of delivery for each tower, he was appreciative of the effort we had gone to ensure ease of delivery for his staff.

Senior Sargent s 47F also exchanged details with s 47 for future reference and we made an agreed check in of 2:00pm to check how the deliveries went.

We left at 10:20am.

Today seemed much more organised than yesterday.

Tomorrow we will follow the same process and envisage similar volumes as we will recover all carded articles from the Post Office for redelivery to assist the residents.

We also delivered 104 E.P's from Senator Hanson which were all the odd number households at 76 Canning St.

Senator Hansen's office have contacted us today advising there will be a further 100+ Express Post tomorrow.
